

Rule Change Proposals for Dec. 1 2010

Page 76, Rule 1 Steve Ratchford

Contestant spur must be over the break of the horse's shoulders, touching animal when the horse's front feet touch the ground the first time out of the chute. **Points will be incorporated into contestants score for achieving the mark out based on degree of difficulty and points deducted from score when contestant fails to mark animal out.**

- a. **Mark out will be waived if horse stalls or comes out backwards.**
- b. **Mark out will be waived if contestant is fouled prior to animals front feet touching ground the first time out of the chute.**
- c. **Either Judge shall have the option of waiving the mark out rule.**

Page 81, Rule 4 Bareback Bronc Riding Steve Ratchford
Page 83, Rule 4 Saddle Bronc Riding

Contestant spur must be over the break of the horse's shoulders, touching animal when the horse's front feet touch the ground the first time out of the chute. **Points will be incorporated into contestants score for achieving the mark out based on degree of difficulty and points deducted from score when contestant fails to mark animal out.**

- a. **Mark out will be waived if horse stalls or comes out backwards.**

- c. **Either Judge shall have the option of waiving the mark out rule.**

Delete Rule 5 f. page 82 if New Mark out rule passes
Delete Rule 8 j. page 84 if New Mark out rule passes

Page 79 Rule 3 Barriers Steve Ratchford

This rule will replace the rule that is in the current IPRA rule book. If it passes then rule 22 page 93 will be removed.

It shall be the discretion of the line judge whether or not a ten (10) second penalty shall be assessed when barrier is broken, regardless of the position of the ring. No metal may be used on jerkline and neck rope that extends beyond front of chute. Barrier must be tied with string only.

(Remove: Barrier will not be considered broken unless ring falls within eight (8) feet of post. A judge shall over-rule the 8 feet distance if it is obvious the contestant broke the barrier.)

Page 80, Rule 8 Steve Ratchford

If contestant breaks or beats the barrier, a ten (10) second penalty shall be enforced providing the barrier works properly. The horses chest should also break the plane of the barrier, **unless neckrope has already pulled the barrier**, otherwise this is to be considered beating the barrier. Therefore ten (10) seconds is to be added to the time.

Page 72, Rule 2 Judging Methods / Riding Events Steve Ratchford

Add: Judges shall have the option of using ½ points in the evaluating both the ride and animal point shall be recorded in decimal form.

Page 30, Rule 4 Animal Handling Steve Ratchford

In tie-down, **contestant shall provide neck rope or appropriate equipment to prevent horse from turning tail to calf and dragging animal. If a horse does turn tail** to the calf and drags the calf after the roper dismounts, field judge may stop the horse and disqualify the roper.

Deleteing: contestant must adjust neck rope and reins in a matter what will prevent horse from dragging calf.

If passes change Page 33, Rule 1, f.

Page 33, Rule 1,f. add Clayton Macom
Neck Rope must be used in tie-down roping.

Page 33, Rule 2. Add Clayton Macom
No exposed wire on nose band or any of contestants equipment.

Page 36, Rule 3 Clayton Macom

Delete: It is recommended that timers use a large ten second sweep watches in the riding events. Digital watches are recommended in the timed event.

Replace with:
Digital Stop watches in all events

Page 61, Rule 3 Clayton Macom

All Roughstock will be drawn one (1) performance at a time. (Same as Timed Events).

Delete: In all riding events, a complete go-round will be drawn for at one time.....

New Rule Clayton Macom

Cowgirls Breakaway Roping will be an added event, points will be kept and World Champion Awards at IFR, top 15 will compete at IFR;
Event will NOT be mandatory at all Rodeos.

(Example 1st year – 3 go arounds thur. morning, 5 contestants in 3 perfs of IFR)

Page 26 Rule 39

Clayton Macom

No rodeos with back to back dates and/or performances will be sanctioned.

Lenora Nolan (Big Hat Rodeo Co.)

Multiple single performance rodeos at the sam location cannot be held on the same day or consecutive days.

If the above rule does not pass: Dale Yerigan

If back to back rodeos are held at the same location Stock Contractor will only receive credit for one rodeo.

Delete:

Timers and secretary are required to wear long sleeved shirts while on the announcers stand. It is recommended that western hats be worn also.

Add Rule to Sanction Rules:

Dale Yerigan

The IPRA may sanction "BULLS and BRONC" competitions with BB< SB< and BR if there is a minimum of \$1,500/event adm. All other sanction rules apply and if there are other sanctioned events held in conjunction with these competitions they must meet normal sanctioning rules. (example: CBR \$500 adm) Current IPRA sanctioned rodeos may not charge to this format but will be allowed to host one of the competitions in addition to their IPRA sanctioned rodeo.

Change the Pay Off Scale to:

- Are you in favor of changing the pay off scale in the Bull Riding, Steer Wrestling, Tie-Down roping, Cowgirls Barrel Racing and Team Roping to the following:

Less than \$600.00 pays two places to be divided 60%, 40%
 \$600.00-\$999 pays 3 places to be divided 50%, 30%, 20%
 \$1,000-\$1,999 pays 4 places divided 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%
 \$2,000-\$4,999 pays 6 places divided **29%, 24%, 19%, 14%, 9%, 5%**
 \$5,000 or more pays eight places to be divided **23%, 20%, 17%, 14%, 11%, 8%, 5%, 2%**

Page 23, Rule 25. Entry Fee Scale

\$50.00	\$500 or less adm.
\$50-60	\$501 - \$999
\$70	\$1000 - \$1200
\$80	\$1201 - \$1500
\$90	\$1501 - \$2000
\$100	\$2001 or more

(or board can set max)

All timed event stock is to be run in order including slack. Exceptions will be made for splits riding the same horse if splits are done before the rodeo.
